

MIS@ASIA Overview

MIS@ASIA (Music Information Society at Asia) is a premier performing rights organization in Asia. Its primary mission is to ensure that composers, authors, and publishers are fairly compensated for the public performance and broadcast of their music. MIS@ASIA achieves this by managing music rights, issuing licenses, collecting fees, and distributing royalties from various performance and usage sources across the region.

Royalty Distribution Process

1. Royalty Collection

- Licensing: MIS@ASIA grants licenses to a diverse range of users, including:
 - **Radio Stations:** For airing music over the airwaves.
 - o **Television Networks:** For including music in broadcasts.
 - o **Live Venues:** For live performances, such as concerts and events.
 - Restaurants and Retail Establishments: For background music played in public spaces.
 - Digital Platforms: Including streaming services and online video platforms. These licenses authorize users to publicly perform or broadcast music from MIS@ASIA's extensive repertoire.
- **Fees:** Licensing fees are determined based on several factors:

3. Royalty Calculation



- **Software Tools:** MIS@ASIA utilizes sophisticated royalty management software to process and calculate royalties. This software:
 - o **Processes Data:** Analyzes the integrated data from various sources.
 - Calculates Royalties: Based on the frequency, type of performance, and contractual agreements.
- **Distribution Algorithms:** Advanced algorithms are applied to distribute royalties fairly among members. Considerations include:
 - o **Popularity of Songs:** More popular songs may earn higher royalties.
 - Extent of Usage: The broader the use of a song, the larger the share of royalties it may generate.

4. Payment and Reporting

- Statements: Members receive detailed statements that outline:
 - o **Earnings Breakdown:** How royalties were earned and the calculation basis.
 - o **Usage Information:** Details on the performance or broadcast of their works.
- Payments: MIS@ASIA processes royalty payments on a scheduled basis, ensuring that members receive timely and accurate compensation for their works. Payments can include direct deposits or checks, depending on member preferences.
